

DRIVER EDUCATION

The CISD certified Driver Education program is for high school students who **meet TEA and CHS (or home high school) guidelines for attendance and are eligible to receive a VOE from their home high school.** If you have any concerns regarding your student's ability to receive a VOE, please verify prior to starting the class.

Maximum class size is 36 students.

Course Options: (Choose one when registering)

Concurrent Method – Students will receive their certificate after the first 6 -10 hours of class instruction and will be able to obtain their Learner’s Permit and begin the behind the wheel instruction while continuing with the classroom instruction. **Due to COVID-19 Driving Instruction may take longer than normal.**

Cost- \$325

Block Method – Students will not receive their certificate to test for their Learner’s Permit until all 32 hours of class instruction have been completed. After a student has obtained their Learner’s Permit they can begin the behind the wheel portion of Driver Education.

Cost- Classroom Instruction only - \$175, Behind the wheel instruction - \$175

DRIVING PHASE

The 14 hours of required in-car driving instruction are scheduled for groups of 2 students. Students must be 15 years old, obtain a learners permit and pay the driving fee before instruction can be scheduled. ****Students who “no-show” to scheduled driving instruction can incur a \$25 penalty.**

******Please be prepared to drive with your student after they have obtained their learners permit. Students who have little or no driving experience prior to driving with our instructor are at a disadvantage and may not master all areas of driving without additional practice. Parents must also drive with their student for an additional 30 hours (10 hours at night) before a student can obtain a Driver’s License.**

ABSENCE POLICY (Please read carefully)

Students must attend 32 hours of class. If a class is missed a make-up session must be attended, however, only 2 make-up sessions are included in the cost of registration. Any student needing to make up more than 2 classes, must first have instructor approval and must pay **\$50 per make-up class.**
